

WHO ARE WE?

The Stoneham School Building Committee (SSBC) is comprised of municipal employees from the School and Town departments, elected representatives from the Select Board, School Committee and Finance & Advisory Board and citizens with a variety of talents and skills suited to the work of bringing a 21st century high school to the students and community of Stoneham.

WHY IS THIS IMPORTANT NOW?

The current Stoneham High School building, while compliant with building codes, has some accessibility challenges.

Classrooms and labs are outdated and inflexible.

The building is energy inefficient and expensive to operate — temperature controls are a challenge in all seasons due to outdated mechanical systems.

Technology, which plays a significant role every day in learning and is an ongoing challenge as students, faculty and administrators use electronic devices for more and more of their daily work.

A new high school would be ecofriendly, environmentally sustainable and energy efficient, creating real savings for Stoneham and its taxpayers.
