The State of Massachusetts has been hailed across the country for its steadfast vigilance and response to the COVID-19 pandemic. The residents of Stoneham have shown courtesy and grace as they have dealt with the vast changes to everyday life that we all have experienced. The Commonwealth's public health metrics including transmission rate and mortality rate are at their lowest since the beginning of the pandemic in March. The Town of Stoneham has witnessed a severe drop-off in reported cases, with only 38 cases being reported in the past 30 days. The Stoneham Board of Health will continue to advise residents on proper guidelines to follow as the Commonwealth continues its phased approach to opening different types of businesses.
