

Board of Health Press Release - 8/5/20

On August 1st, Governor Baker's travel order went into effect, requiring all out of state visitors to quarantine for 14 days upon arrival, or to produce a negative COVID test result within 72 hours of travel date. As the Commonwealth continues to draft plans for school opening in the fall, the re-opening phase still remains at Phase III - Part 1 (7/6/20). The Stoneham Board of Health has visited all Stoneham schools to advise on re-opening plans. The Department of Education will continue to draft base guidelines for all municipalities in the Commonwealth in the coming weeks. COVID-19 guidelines will remain largely the same through the phasing and school opening process, with 6' distancing and face coverings continuing to remain on the forefront for resident protection. As further information becomes available, the Board of Health will update as needed. Again, as always, thank you for your continued vigilance in this uncertain time and fluid situation.
